

100 Points of Identification Recognition of Prior Learning

To apply for RPL you must provide proof of identity. You must hold and submit 100 points of documents, from the below list, when you lodge your application.

Combined, these documents should show evidence of:

- your full name
- date of birth
- current residential address
- your signature
- a photo of yourself

All documents must be original as supplied.
